Head to the Arctic this summer with the Climate One Arctic Adventurer Scholarship. We are offering an incredible opportunity to a deserving high school student from the Bay Area to travel to the Arctic on scholarship. For the last 7 years, we have partnered with an amazing organization called Students on Ice (SOI) to send one student to the Arctic. Our goal being to make sure the next generation has an opportunity to develop a deep understanding of climate change, and how things up north affect us down south.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for our scholarship, you must be in high school at the time of application. If you graduate this spring, you are still eligible. Each interested student must attend our upcoming event, [“Mindful Travel in the Age of Climate Change,”](#) on March 19 at 110 The Embarcadero, San Francisco. Program starts at 6:30pm. We encourage you and any interested students to start reviewing the available information now and gathering materials that will need to be submitted!

Timeline

Application deadline is March 30th, 2018. It is best for you to start the application process before attending the Climate One event. You will receive any final instructions at the Climate One event.

Application Review Process

You will apply directly to Students on Ice, and they will choose the awardee based on their requirements. Further instructions below.
